

COACH RESPONSIBILITIES

Purpose

The primary role of coach is to promote the enjoyment of participation and team spirit amongst our teams and to develop our player's netball skills, knowledge and team understanding in a safe environment.

Prerequisite

- Hold a Working with Children Check or equivalent
- Be contactable via email and mobile to the Team Manager, players and parents
- Able to commit time to training and Game day
- Be familiar with Netball Rules and Club Policies, Procedures, Codes of Conduct (Club, VIC, Player and Child Safety)

Development Opportunities

- Complete Netball Victoria On-line Umpiring Course
- Participation in Internal and External Coaching Support / Courses co-ordinated by the club

Responsibilities

- Work with the Team Manager to finalise team lists.
- Maintain a current VNA Registration (this will be provided by the Club where the coach does not hold a registration outside the competition).
- Coach the team on game days involving direction, encouragement and positional changes.
- When players complain about "bad" umpiring - remind them of swings and roundabouts - umpires do their best / volunteer their time / and their opponents face the same umpires for the same amount of time.
- Respond to parents queries about team play.
- Conduct training sessions (where possible) with a focus on skill, fitness and tactical development.
- Ensure players are picked up by their parents at the end of training sessions before you leave the courts.
- If a player needs to go to the toilet or get a drink they must go with another team mate.
- Adhere to the Club policies, procedures and Codes of Conduct when working with children and young people in netball.
- Be familiar with the competition By-Laws as they pertain to the game regulations.
